The patient presenting this leaflet has diabetes and falls into the nationally recognised "At risk" category of developing a foot ulcer.

In conformance with the guidelines from NICE & SIGN, (prevention and management of foot problems in diabetes) your patient has been evaluated for the appropriate provision of specialist footwear and/or insoles in order to minimise this possibility.

The primary causes of foot ulcers are a combination of excessive peak forefoot pressure and poor tissue perfusion due to reduced circulation. Liqua Care Diabetic Flowgel Orthotics have been clinically proven to offload peak pressures and significantly increase the circulation.
